

# Trail Accessibility Checklist

No	Access Priorities	✓
01	<b>Entrance</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Direct, unobstructed access from the parking lot to the trail</li> <li>➤ Clear signage identifying the trail entrance</li> </ul>	
02	<b>Pathways &amp; Ramps</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Provide at least 1200 mm (minimum) width at locations with site constraints</li> <li>➤ Include passing space of 1830 mm (minimum) wide by 1830 mm (minimum) long, at intervals of 50 m or less</li> <li>➤ Running slope with the ratio between 1:12 (8.33%) and 1:20 (5%)</li> </ul>	
03	<b>Trail Surfacing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Paved or finely crushed pea gravel/crusher dust</li> <li>➤ Track their attendance and participation in training.</li> </ul>	
04	<b>Edge Protection</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Clearly defined edges</li> <li>➤ Suitable protection at level changes, cliffs, etc</li> </ul>	
05	<b>Seating</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Offer seating or rest areas at regular intervals, off the main path of travel</li> <li>➤ Ensure seating can be accessed - i.e., is not on a platform</li> </ul>	
06	<b>Maintenance</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Establish a maintenance plan and point of contact for feedback or concerns</li> </ul>	
07	<b>Restroom</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Restrooms are not always feasible for trails - if one is available, advertise its level of accessibility</li> </ul>
